The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection; This risk assessment will be reviewed on a weekly basis;
- Do our utmost to strictly adhere to the social distancing and face covering rules as set out by the government;
- Support your child's holistic development through a combination of enriching and engaging learning opportunities;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child is unwell;
- If a student or staff member who has been in school has a positive COVID test result, we will work with NHS Track & Trace and Public Health England to take appropriate action;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website;

Parent

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- I will be mindful of my child's temperature every day before I send my child to school and will not send them to school if their temperature is raised;
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family. I will get my child tested if they show symptoms and I will let the school know the result as soon as possible via telephone and email;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child and any siblings from school immediately;
- If my child, or anyone in my household, has underlying health conditions identified by the government and is deemed a potential risk, I will strictly adhere to government guidelines;
- If I drop my child off and/or pick them up from school I will do this outside of the school grounds. If I use public transport, I will only use this if absolutely necessary and I will ensure I socially distance wherever possible and wear a face covering if I do;
- I will remind my child about social distancing and face covering rules and their need to abide by these at all times – on their journey to and from school and whilst at school. I will ensure my child has a suitable face covering to wear;
- I understand that my child will need to use good hand hygiene and will use hand sanitiser when instructed;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment and will therefore communicate via telephone or email in the first instance;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contact details and ensure that there is a local phone number available at all times;
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

Student

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules on my journey to school, whilst at school and on my journey home from school;
- I will only use Public Transport if absolutely necessary and if I do, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules and will wear a face covering as per government guidelines;
- I will ensure I bring a plain blue, black or white face covering to school and wear this at all times, except when in a classroom or sat down for break/lunch;
- Tell an adult immediately if I feel unwell;
- Only use my own equipment in school;
- I understand that our canteen services have changed and will therefore either bring in a packed lunch to school, or use the online packed lunch ordering service provided by Sodexo;
- On a day where I have PE or Dance, I will wear my PE kit to school;
- Only enter and exit the school building via the designated routes when instructed, and move around the school building as directed;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser when instructed;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
