Career paths:

This qualification is for students who wish to develop applied knowledge and practical skills within the health and social care sector. What can I do after I have completed this course?

The BTEC Level 1/2 in Health and Social Care prepares students to enter employment or apprenticeships, or for a move to higher education to study a degree in the health and social care sectors or in related sectors such as nursing and the early years sector.

Students can look to undertake complementary study in BTEC Level 1/2 Tech Award Child Development. In sixth form, students can follow this subject pathways into BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate or Diploma in Health and Social Care and/or BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate in Children's Play, Learning and Development
