Dear Parent/Guardian,

The following guidance should help you to support your child in completing their work:

- Staff will use Show My Homework (SMH) to set homework, although it is good practice for students to record each homework in their diary.
- Members of staff give an indication of the expected time required to undertake each homework on SMH. All students are expected to complete their homework by the deadline set, including during periods of absence wherever possible.
- All students are expected to do their homework to the best of their ability, as it will develop their skills to work independently and enable them to build a deeper understanding of the work they have completed in class.
- Homework will not always involve written work. It could be reading, listening, observing, researching or practising a particular skill.
- Homework for each subject will, wherever possible, be set on the specific day detailed in the tables on the next page. This is separated by Year group and then band (G/H). Please note that staff may, on occasion, need to set homework outside of these times. Students will also be given a date for handing in the homework. Please help your child in planning his or her time so that all homework is completed by the date it is due.
- Homework will only be set when it is appropriate; if students have not been set homework, 'None set' should be written in the planner.
- All students are supplied with a planner, which has space for them to write in their homework on the day it is set and the date that it is due in. Please support us by checking this with your child. This can be reviewed each weekend when students' diaries are signed ready for Monday.
- Staff will put sanctions in place if homework is not completed, if the homework deadline is missed, or if the work produced falls below the standard expected.
- Please contact the school if your child is experiencing difficulties with homework.
- If there is an issue with printing worksheets or homework, students must see their teacher prior to the lesson. Printing is available to all students at Homework Club which takes places in Room C6 before and after school every day.
- PE, Drama and Dance are not part of the homework timetable, but homework in these subject areas may be set occasionally.
- Good quality homework is rewarded through the use of good comments, and may be used as display work to celebrate achievements or share as exemplar work with other students.
